

GOVERNMENT DONATES 100 BUSES TO SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE NORTHERN SECTOR

The Vice President of the Republic Alhaji Dr Mahamudu Bawumia, has presented 100 brand new 33seater Hyundai buses to the Ghana Education Service in a short ceremony at the forecourt of Parliament House, Accra.

The Vice President, in an address explained that these buses are meant for 100 senior high schools in the northern enclave covering regions such as; Northern, Savanna, North East, Upper East, Upper West, Bono, Bono East, Ahafo and Oti regions of Ghana.

'Government is determined to provide the required logistics and infrastructure to the senior high schools to ensure smooth operations and management of schools leading to improved learning outcomes', Dr Bawumia said.

The Director General of the Ghana Education Service, Prof Kwasi Opoku-Amankwa, was grateful to government and in a characteristic fashion of the proverbial "Oliver Twist" asked for more of these buses to all underserved schools in the country.
