## **REACTION OF MANAGEMENT OF GHANA EDUCATION SERVICE TO ISSUES OF INDISCIPLINE IN SCHOOLS**

As requested by H. E. the President of the Republic, the Hon Minister of Education has engaged the Management of Ghana Education Service today 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020, to review sanctions imposed on the students who misconducted themselves after the Integrated Science Examination Paper on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2020.

In the light of the review, the following decisions have been made:

1. The underlisted students are permitted to write their WASSCE in their respective schools.
  - a) **Nicholas Cobblinah, Kardimell Suapim and John Kwofie** all of Sekondi College
  - b) **Simon Ameyibor**, who is the Senior Prefect and **Juliet Amoakowaa** all of Tweneboa Kodua Senior High School.
  - c) **Emmanuel Ashiangmor, Peter Sissl, Ameka Nyamitse, Shadrack Daitey and Alfred Attiso** of Battor Senior High School
  - d) **Solomon Brako, Albert Agyekum and Robert Inkoom** of Juaben Senior High School.
2. However, the following disciplinary actions taken earlier still remain:
  - a. The 13 students named above are dismissed. They are to leave the various school compounds immediately.
  - b. Heads of the affected schools should allow the students involved to come to the compounds to write any paper they are due under guardian escort.

- c. They should leave the compounds immediately after the paper with their guardians.
- d. All students who are in schools where destruction of school property occurred are to be surcharged for the full cost of the damage. Results of these students will be withheld till they have fully paid for the full cost of the items destroyed.
- e. Further, all acts of vandalism and other criminal acts must be reported to the security agencies for further investigations.
- f. The action taken against teachers who are alleged to have violated exams rules and are undergoing investigation also remains.
